¿Qué lugares hay en una ciudad? (What places are there in a town?)



Main questions and replies:

¿Hay un banco por aquí? – Is there a bank around here?

Sí. El banco es todo recto y la segunda calle a la izquierda. – Yes. The bank is straight on then the second street on the left.

¿Dónde está el cine? – Where is the cinema?

Es en el centro de la ciudad. Toma la primera calle a la derecha y la tercera calle a la izquierda. – It's in the town centre. Take the first street on the right and then the third street on the left.

Prior learning

Basic greetings, numbers 1 - 200, days/months, pets, family members, nationalities, body parts, colours, following classroom instructions.

Remember:

Places within a town use different determiners depending on whether they are considered masculine or feminine. Most place names ending in the letter 'a' are feminine and would therefore use the feminine determiner:

la/una playa – the/a beach

If the place name ends in any other letter, this will usually be considered masculine and will use the masculine determiner:

el/un banco – the/a bank.
