Una hora – An hour

Un minute – A minute

Un segundo – A second

Son las tres – It is three o'clock

...y cinco – Five past ...

...y diez – Ten past...

...y cuarto – Quarter past...

...y media – Half past...

...menos cuarto – Quarter to...

...menos veinte – Twenty to...

De la mañana – In the morning

De la tarde – In the afternoon

De la noche – In the evening

Mediodía – Midday

Media noche – Midnight

Me levanto... – I get up...

Me acuesto – I go to bed...

Voy a la escuela... - I go to school.

¿Qué hora es?

(What time is it?)



Main questions and replies:

¿Qué hora es? – What time is it?

Son las tres y media – It is half past three.

¿A qué hora te levantas? – What time do you get up?

Me levanto a las siete y cuarto – I get up at quarter past seven.

¿Cuántos minutos son hasta la cena? – How many minutes is it until dinner?

Hay veinte minutos hasta la cena – There are twenty minutes until dinner.

Prior learning

Basic greetings, numbers 1 -200, days/months, pets, family members, nationalities, body parts, colours, following classroom instructions, describing school, giving directions, places in a town.

Remember:

When telling the time in English, we would say the number of minutes past followed by the hour:

eg. It is ten past four.

When telling the time in Spanish, they say the hour first followed by how many minutes past:

eg. Son las cuatro y diez
